- 1. Pay the registration fees and fill out the registration form through the University's website, following the relevant instructions.
- 2. Submit a photocopy of your identity document.
- 3. Verify a professional degree, diploma or certificate in any of the subjects related to biomedicine, issued by a higher education body and officially recognized nationally. For degrees obtained abroad, the corresponding validation or degree duly certified by the relevant authority in the country of origin (consulate, chancellery) must be confirmed.
- 4. Submit your resume and supporting documents certifying:
- Undergraduate and graduate degrees (if any).
- Academic awards and distinctions.
- Average credit in undergraduate studies.
- Postgraduate studies (if any).
- Certified work experience as a professional, in teaching and/or support.
- Certified research experience, not including degree work.
- Attendance at events related to biomedical sciences in the last three years (includes journal clubs, seedbeds, seminars, courses, symposia, conferences).
- Presentations at events related to biomedical sciences.
- Accredited participation in programs as a monitor, young researcher, administrative assistant.
- National and international publications.
