Written exam on basic knowledge of basic sciences with a maximum weighting of 30%.
Basis for a research article, related to the focus and line of research provided by the Academic Corporation for Basic Biomedical Sciences and suggested by the teacher who offers the position, with a maximum weighting of 30%.

3. Intention interview with a maximum weighting of 10%.

4. Resume with a maximum weighting of 30%

Note 1: Reading proficiency in English will be a requirement for enrolling in the third semester of the Basic Biomedical Sciences Masters, as established by Academic Agreement 493 of December 03, 2015 and Directive Council Resolution 088 of January 27, 2016. Applicants and students from countries where the official language is not Spanish must prove they have B1 communication skills in Spanish through an objective test designed and administered by the Faculty of Communications or through the DELE B1 Spanish diploma issued by the Cervantes Institute.

Please bear in mind:

• The Basic Biomedical Sciences Masters will last 4 semesters, with 18 weeks per semester.

 This is a full-time master. The activities will be carried out during the day and in person / online.

• The total minimum credits for the program for research will be 64, while the minimum credits for the taught section will be 60.

• No course in the curriculum can be retaken, validated, or classified.

• The requirements for granting the Basic Biomedical Sciences Masters are that the study plan must be approved and support for the research work must be accepted.

• To graduate with this Masters, you must present evidence of exams such as Michigan, Toefl or similar, with which reading proficiency in a second language is accredited (as established in the Resolution of the Board of Directors of the CCBB # 088 of January 27, 2016 based on the Superior Agreement 493 of the University of Antioquia of 2015).

• Before applying to the postgraduate program at the Academic Corporation for Basic Biomedical Sciences of the University of Antioquia (Colombia), foreign students should check the validity of this degree in their country.
